- Participation must be at an AACS school. Home participation is not permitted for these sessions. A school official will be responsible for certifying attendance and active participation.
- Classes must be viewed live. Recordings will not be made available.
- All communication regarding the class and all materials for the class will be communicated electronically (email) to
 one designated recipient at the school. That person will be responsible for distributing information and course
 materials to participants.
- Adobe Connect will not require any registration or licensing at the participant end. It is very intuitive and easily used.
 - Each participant location will be required to log in to a test prior to the class session. The test will ensure that
 equipment and connections function properly and that the person who will be responsible for the equipment at
 the user location understands how to connect and operate the equipment.
 - Test sessions will be offered August 6 at 9:00 AM EDT, August 14 at 11:00 AM EDT and the first day of each class at 11 AM EDT. Each test session is 30 minutes.
