## Orton-Gillingham in the Classroom: A Multisensory Approach

### Associate Level Training, Part 2

New online format! June 22–July 10, 2020

*Instructing and empowering tutors in the art of writing and presenting lessons using Multisensory Instruction and the Orton-Gillingham approach through observation, application, and feedback.*

This 30-hour, intensive course is designed to provide the next step towards the knowledge and skills needed for structured, multisensory reading and spelling instruction vital to dyslexic students and beneficial to all learners in the general classroom setting. It is specifically designed for AACS member school teachers who desire an understanding of dyslexia and how to use multisensory language techniques and principles in the general classroom and small groups.

Participants will receive training manual, manipulatives, and resource books. Participants will receive a certificate of completion for Orton-Gillingham Associate Level Coursework. During this training week, participants will add 30 hours of training to the 30 hours earned during previous Classroom Educator training. This meets the minimum 60 hours of coursework as required by the Academy of Orton-Gillingham Practitioners and Educators to work on the Associate's level certification credential. **Enduring Understanding:** All students benefit from explicit and direct instruction delivered by teachers and tutors with honed skills in the best practices for lesson delivery and post lesson evaluation.

**Prerequisite:** Participants need to have completed a minimum of 30-hour Classroom Educator Level Orton-Gillingham training (sometimes referred to as Associates Level Training, Part 1).

**Topics to be covered in training include:**

- Writing an advanced Orton-Gillingham lesson plan
- Delivering an advanced Orton-Gillingham lesson to a live student
- Diagnostic post-lesson analysis
- Prescriptive next-lesson planning
- Student assessment

This training would be an ideal preparatory class for those about to begin practicums.

**Dates:** Three-week training window June 22–July 10, 2020 (See FAQ document for live training dates.)

**Cost:** Training and resources—\$750
