Orton-Gillingham in the Classroom: A Multisensory Approach
Associate Level Training, Part 2
June 22–July 10, 2020

Why are sessions being taught online instead of in a traditional classroom setting?

COVID-19 has brought a time of social distancing that has caused meeting together in large groups and traveling to cease temporarily. AACCS, along with our training presenter, wants to continue to offer this valuable training in a safe and greatly beneficial venue. We are excited about the flexibility and the opportunity that online training offers.

What is the new schedule for the online training?

The training will be a three-week window from June 22–July 10. A pacing guide will be distributed with the schedule for live training sessions, as well as assignment due dates.

Will I have to be online for continuous hours for this training?

Training videos have been previously recorded so you will be able to follow the provided pacing guide that will allow you to watch and then complete assignments as your schedule allows. Videos will be available to review during the three-week training window and for one week after the training closes. There will be pre-planned, live discussion sessions on June 26, July 3, and July 10 that will be required. During the live sessions, you will have open discussions with the presenter and fellow trainees.

What certification will I receive?

After completion of all videos, assignments, and live sessions, you will receive your completion certificate for the associate level training. Following this training and a practicum, trainees are eligible to apply for Associate's Level certification.

Can I share the videos with others at my school?

No. Your registration is only for one person. Training videos and all materials are copyrighted property of AOGPE. Each trainee will be asked to sign a usage agreement that states that only you will use the training materials provided. We ask that you honor this agreement.

Do I have to complete the course work and attend live sessions?

To complete the training and receive your completion certificate for associate level training, you must complete 100% of the videos, assignments, and live meetings. Course completion is required before practicum may begin.

How will I receive my training materials?

Training materials will be shipped directly to the address provided. Links to live discussions and training videos will be emailed.
